

Ride Rules

- **Make sure your bike is roadworthy. Most breakdowns are for simple maintenance tasks which have been ignored.**
- Make sure your bike is fueled up before we depart. The first stop is around the 100km mark for Sporties only.
- **Pay attention to start times. Don't be late.**
- Never - ever - pass the Road Captain.
- **Ride in staggered formation, not side by side. You must be able to see the riders face in front of you in his rear view mirror to ensure a safe stopping distance.**
- Ride in same lane as the Road Captain in a multi-lane highway.
- **On winding or narrow roads, staggered formation is not advised. Use correct riding style for cornering but leave plenty of room between bikes for braking.**
- Pay attention to departure times for stop points. The ride is on a schedule.
- **If you break down stay with your bike in clear view of the break down vehicle and Tail End Charlie.**
- If you break down or crash two other bikes should stop to provide assistance, one person should direct traffic if required and the other person may be needed to notify the Road Captain.
- **If corner marking stay in place until told to move by the Tail End Charlie.**
