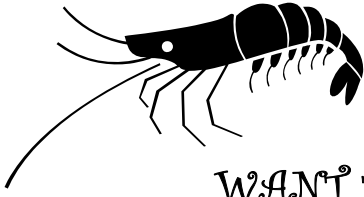


# Seafood Festival Tin Can Bay
